SENTIMENT FLOW & MICROSTRUCTURE

Analysis of order book thickness reveals that institutional blocks are quietly building deep support beds, lowering the risk of sudden liquidity shocks before the upcoming earnings date on Jun 30.

The put-call delta imbalance shows structured hedging behavior, with option traders loading up on put blocks near the \$1627.66 strike, setting up an asymmetric risk profile.
